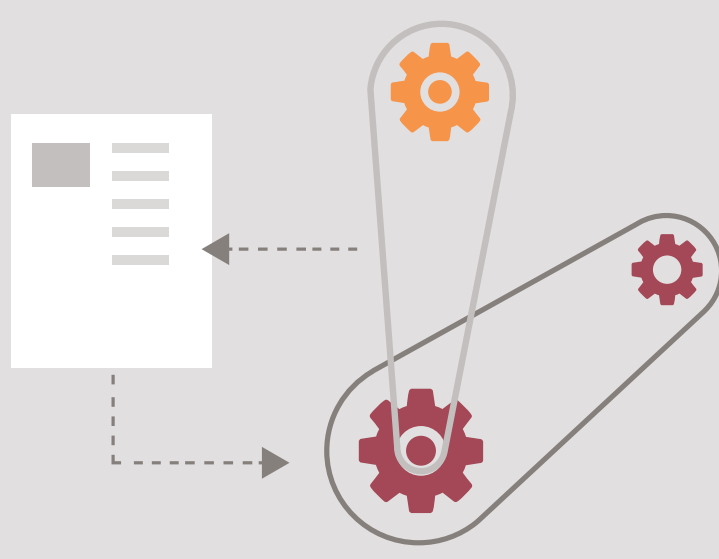

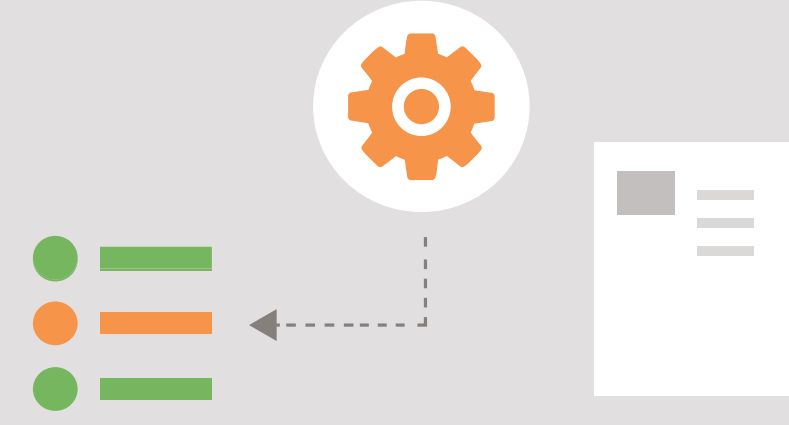

Diverse Processes

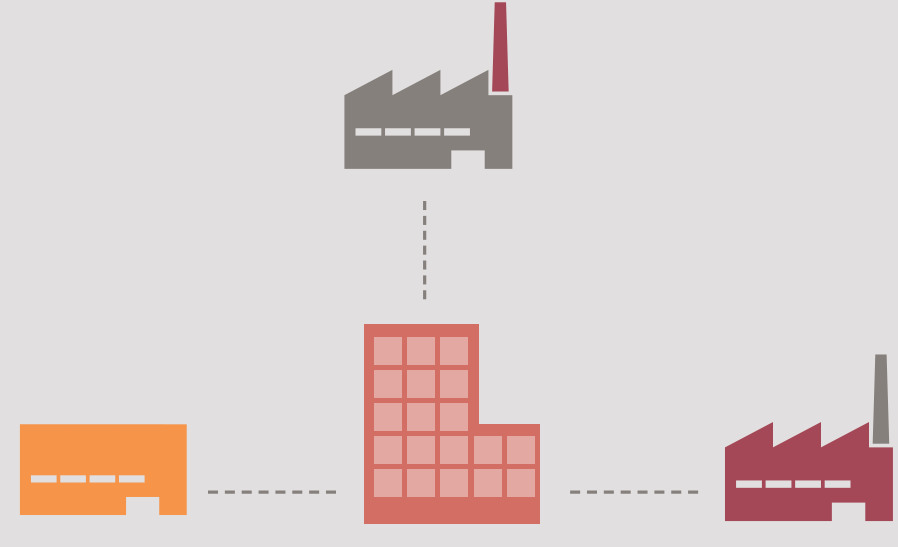
The more processes there are, the more effort it takes to coordinate them. Inconsistencies and irregularities can hinder the processes.



Integrate Processes

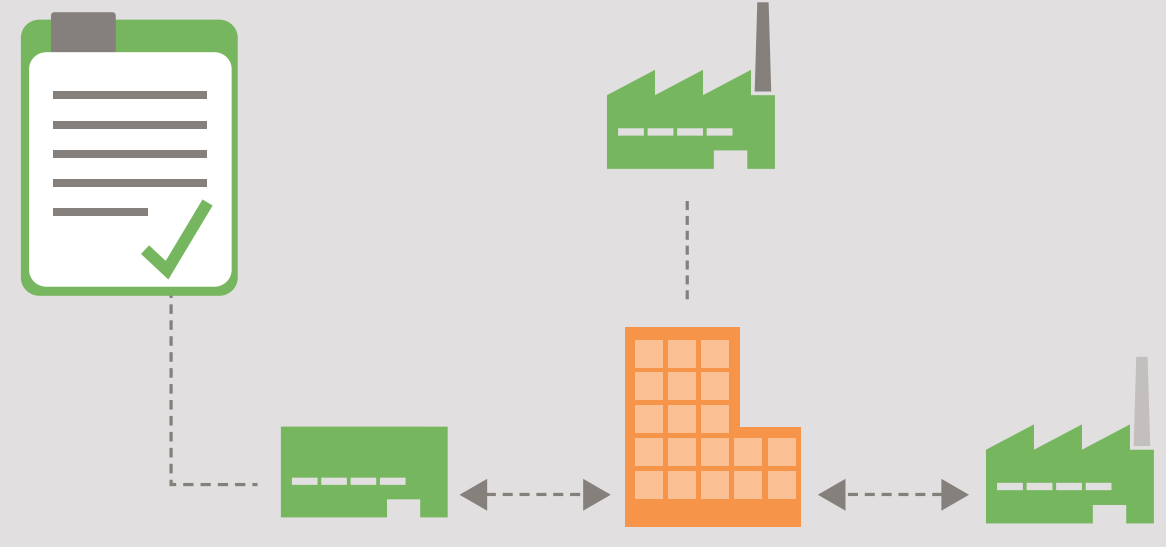

Multiple Locations

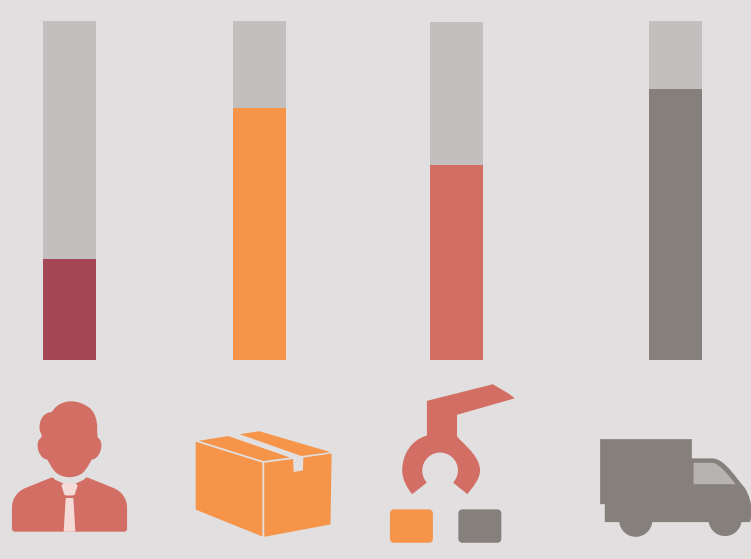
Companies with various production and distribution sites have to consider cross-plant processes in their planning.



Plan External Processes First

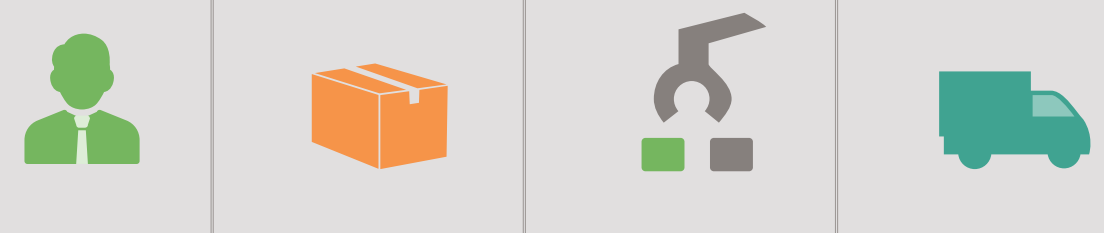
First of all, plan your external sales. Replenishment planning should then follow in the second step, taking into account capacity, transport, and inventory aspects.

Gain a 360-Degree Overview

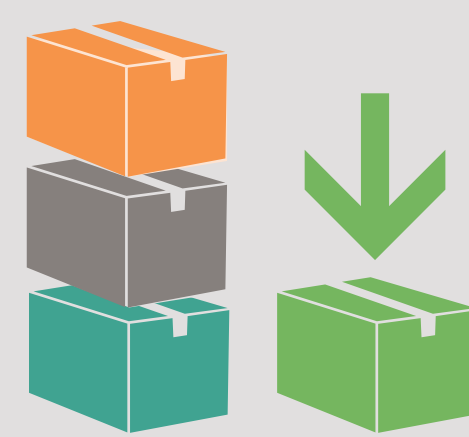
